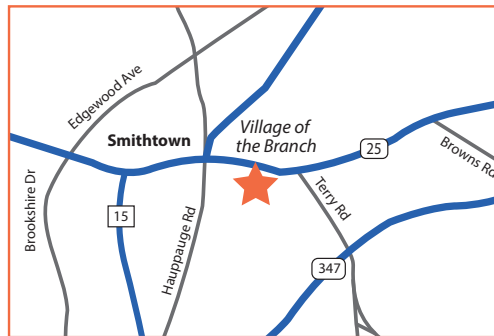

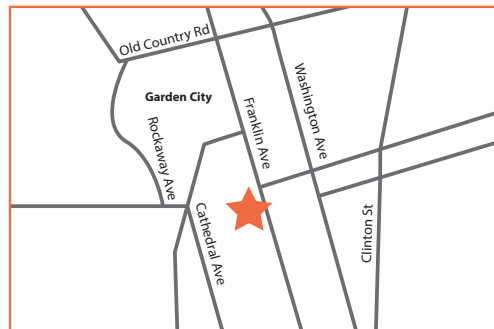

Blepharoplasty

Raises drooping eyelids, reduces sagging skin below the eyes, and eliminate fat deposits in both the upper and lower eyelids.

Orbital Fractures

Surgical treatment involves freeing the muscle and reconstructing the eye socket.

Brow Lifting

Corrects obstruction of peripheral vision.

Ptosis

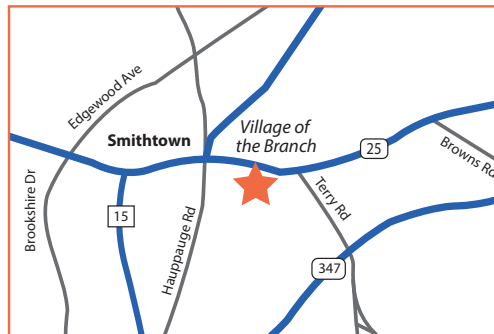

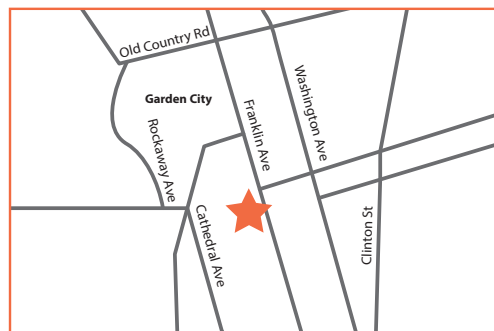

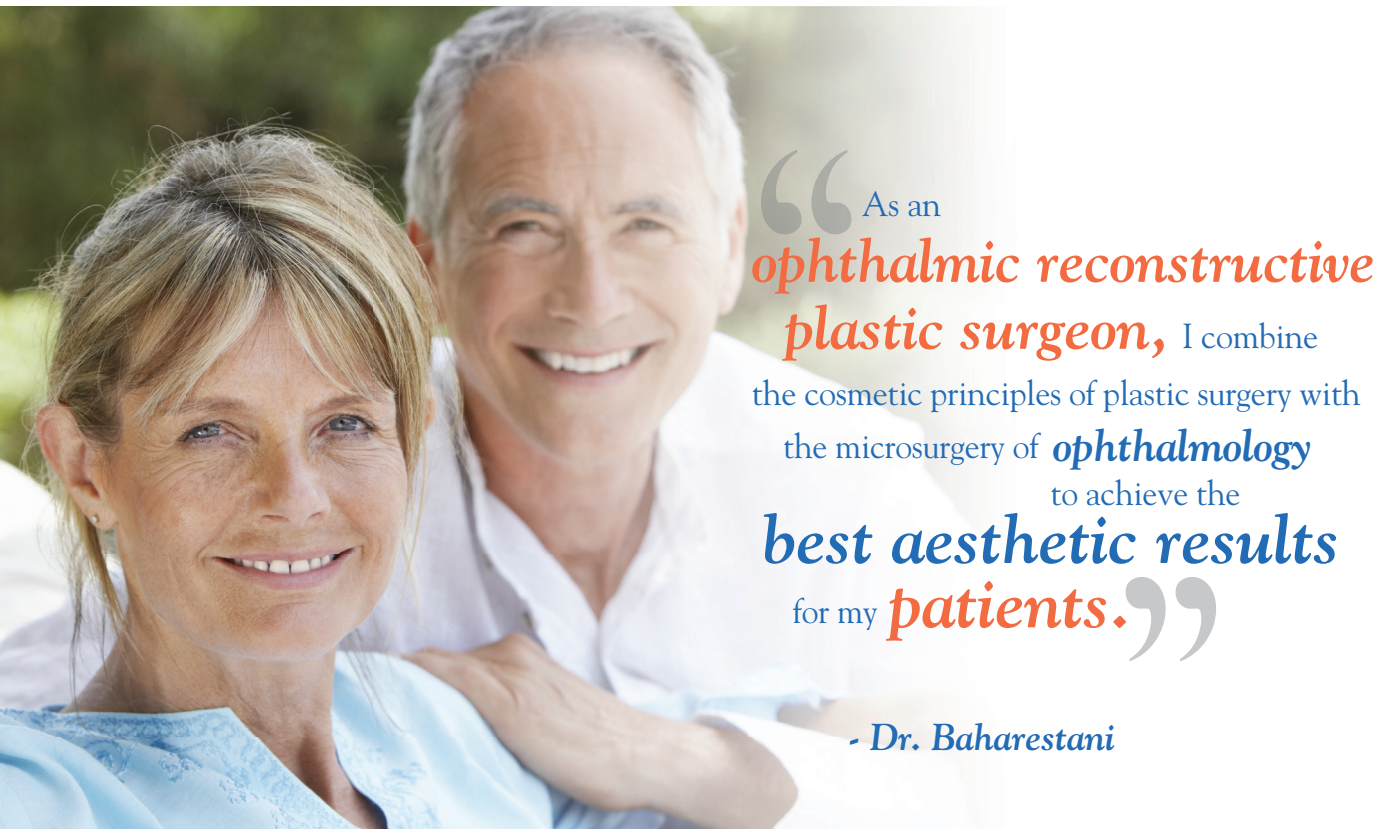
